

## Read 180 Daily Expectations

*Ultimate Goal: Keep all students working and engaged the entire class period. The classroom must be silent for this to happen.*

### General:

- **Stay polite and respectful when speaking to students and teachers. Remember these classroom expectations**
- Make sure you are focused for the entire class time.
- Cell phones and cell phone accessories(chargers and headphones) should not be out or seen.
- There should not be any food or drink out unless during break. Once the bell rings after break, food and drink need to be put up.
- Students are to use the bathroom before and after class not during.
- Everyone should be seated in their assigned seat as soon as they enter the classroom. The only time you should be up is if the bell rings, you have permission, or we are rotating. If you have a problem or need something, raise your hand and wait quietly and patiently.
- During rotations: move quickly, quietly, and keep hands to self
- Make sure your materials(books/workbooks/headphones/clip boards/Chromebooks/pencils) back where they belong.
- **LEADERS:** There will be one leader per group. If they cannot complete the expectations,I will choose a new leader. It is a leader's job to make sure their group gets their workbooks at the beginning of class and they get put up correctly at the end of class. They are also in charge of checking their station at the end of the rotation to make sure everything has been put up correctly.
- **Conferencing:** All students should know their lexile levels and their progress at each station. How are they YOU doing on the app? What is YOUR time? How many words have YOU read? How many points to do YOU have?

### Independent Reading( 2 books/Ebooks and 2 Ereads per nine weeks):

- **Are you actively reading and focused? You should be focused on your book or chromebook the entire rotation.**
- Do not sit in a way that will allow for you to fall asleep(“Eyes on pages/screen or on your reading log”)
- Are you reading a book or Ebook on their lexile level(100 above or 50 below)?
  - Ereads are 4-5 page articles about 900 lexile and above. They should not take more than a 2 days for you to read and quiz on it. Read it three times before you quiz.
  - 7-10 pages every day-if more, you are reading too fast
- If you are having it read to you, follow along with the words. Just listening will not help.
- Are you filling out your reading log every single day? (“Read a page and write about it”)(Who?What?When?Where?Why?)
  - Even if you are absent, you should write absent where you were not here. If you were quizzing, you should write “taking a quiz”

### Student App (17-20 minutes daily on the app):

- This station should not be interrupted
- Use the HMH Read180 link in the TCSS Apps or the bookmark on the chromebooks
- You should be facing their computer.
- You should not unplug anything from the computer
- Is the screen changing every 20-30 seconds? ( if not, it will pause the your time)
- Are your headphones on correctly?
- Are you correctly completing the zone or just clicking
- It should take you 7-10 school days to finish a segment

*\*If a you will not follow the expectations of the classroom and you are a disruption to the learning environment-we will have to follow the discipline protocol.*
