

## Rules for winning the All Pro Chevrolet Attendance and PBIS Incentive Program drawing for a car.

- The purpose of this incentive program is to encourage improved school attendance, academic performance, and appropriate behaviors for students who attend Callaway High School. The rules as described below are intended to allow all students an equal opportunity to be awarded for positive behaviors. The rules are also intended to allow students the opportunity to improve their performance over time and still retain their eligibility for reward.
- Every two weeks students will be eligible to participate in Hero Days based on their Hero point totals.
- Every 9 weeks students will be eligible for drawings for various awards based on their Hero point totals.
- Every semester students will be eligible to attend a special student assembly based on their Hero point totals.
- During May 2018, students will be eligible for a drawing for the All Pro Chevrolet car based on their Hero point totals.
- Hero points will be awarded at the discretion of TCSS staff for being courteous, capable, and cooperative. Targeted behaviors will be defined for each two-week period and will be announced on the intercom.
- The first Hero day will be on September 1, 2017.
- To participate in the first Hero day students must have 56 or more Hero points.
- After this point, students with Hero points for a given two-week period totaling at least 80% of the highest Hero point total will be eligible to participate in Hero days.
- Each 9-week grading period students will be awarded extra Hero points for good behavior, good attendance and good grades.
- Each 9-week period students with no referrals for the 9 weeks will receive 10 Hero points.
- Each 9-week period students with 3 or less absences for the 9 weeks will receive 10 Hero points. Absences will be calculated on a by-period basis where 7 periods of absences equals 1 day.
- Each 9-week period students with all A's will receive 30 Hero points.
- Each 9-week period students with all A's and B's will receive 20 Hero points.
- Each 9-week period students with all passing grades will receive 10 Hero points.
- At the end of each semester, students will be eligible to earn tickets to be placed in the drawing for the All Pro Chevrolet car.
- The student with the highest point total at the end of a semester will receive 10 tickets.
- Students within 10% of the highest point total will receive 8 tickets.
- Students within 20% of the highest point total will receive 4 tickets
- Point totals will start over at the beginning of semester 2.
- The same rules as described above will apply for second semester.
- Points will stop being awarded on May 10 and the final Pep Rally will be held on May 11.
- During the month of May 2018, all tickets will be placed in a drum and one ticket will be drawn during a pep rally. The student whose name appears on this ticket will win the All Pro Chevrolet car.
- Students who attend THINC Academy will have their point totals doubled in order to place them on equal status with students who attend Callaway for 7 periods. Grades, attendance, and behavior points will not be doubled.
- Points for students in the MOWR program will be adjusted on a per-student basis based on the percentage of the day a student attends Callaway High School. MOWR students who do not attend CHS for any portion of the day will not be eligible for Hero points.
- The car will be similar in value to the car shown in the video posted to the Callaway High Facebook page on August 18, 2017.
- Rules may be altered during the school year as deemed necessary by the CHS administrative staff for the success of the PBIS incentive program. All rule adjustments will be announced within 24 hours of the rule change.
