## Community Spaces for Internet Access

### Family Guidelines

In Troup County, we have many community partners that wrap around students and families to promote academic success. If your family is in need of using space in any of our listed community partners' facilities, please follow these guidelines:

- Adults need to accompany students to community facilities. Students should not be dropped off at the facility without an adult.
- A list of community partners is available so that families can determine which facilities are the most convenient for them. Each partner is able to offer different things for families. Please read carefully to find a facility that best suits your family's needs.
- Each community partner may have additional guidelines to share with you when your family arrives to share their space. Please be prepared with masks for your family members in case they require masks.
- Lunches for TCSS students will not be delivered to community facilities. There will be several sites throughout the community that families can pick up 5 days worth of breakfasts and lunches for their school-aged children who are choosing Troup County Virtual Academy. These lunches are for TCSS students only.
